Annexe 1 - Mandatory Conditions

(a) No supply of alcohol may be made at a time when no designated premises supervisor has been specified in the licence or at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his or her licence has been suspended.

(b) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

All persons present on the premises who are required to carry out a security activity must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

Embedded Conditions

Annexe 2 - Conditions Consistent With the Operating Schedule

- 1 CCTV shall be installed and maintained in a working condition.
- 2 All CCTV recordings shall be kept for 31 days and shall be made available to police and licensing officers if requested.
- 3 A personal licence holder fluent in English shall be present on the premises and supervise the sale of alcohol throughout the permitted hours for the sale of alcohol.
- 4 No high strength beers, lagers, and ciders above 5.5% ABV shall be stocked.

5 "Raid Control" crime prevention measures shall be installed and all staff given suitable training.

6 A copy of the premises licence summary including the hours which licensable activities are permitted shall be visible from the outside of each entrance to the premises.

7 Photographic proof of age shall be required from all persons appearing to be under the age of 21.
