An officer of the Metropolitan Police, in whose area the premises are situated, who is authorised for the purposes of exercising its statutory function as a 'Responsible Authority' under the Licensing Act 2003.

The application has been made to vary the premises licence under section 34 of the act.

The Police representations are primarily concerned with crime and disorder and prevention of public nuisance.

Police require the following two points should be included in the operating schedule or added as conditions on the premises licence.

- No high strength beers, lagers, and ciders above 6.0% ABV shall be stocked, with the exception of a maximum of six brands of beers up to 8.0% AVB that will be stored behind the serving counter located with the spirits and will be individually labelled with the name of the shop.

- There will be no sales of single cans, or bottles of Beers, Lagers, or Cider, above 6% AVB and a sign reading 'No sale of Single can's or Bottles' will be displayed at the point of sale.

Brent has a street drinking problem which is predominately eastern European males that stand around drinking high strength beers, Brent currently is a controlled drinking Zone (CDZ) due to the street drinking issues it suffers, having control of the high strength beers by having them behind the counter will help reduce street drinkers and drunks having the drinks to hand and allow the shop keeper to make a decision as to who is sold these beers, this will help promote the licensing objectives.
