



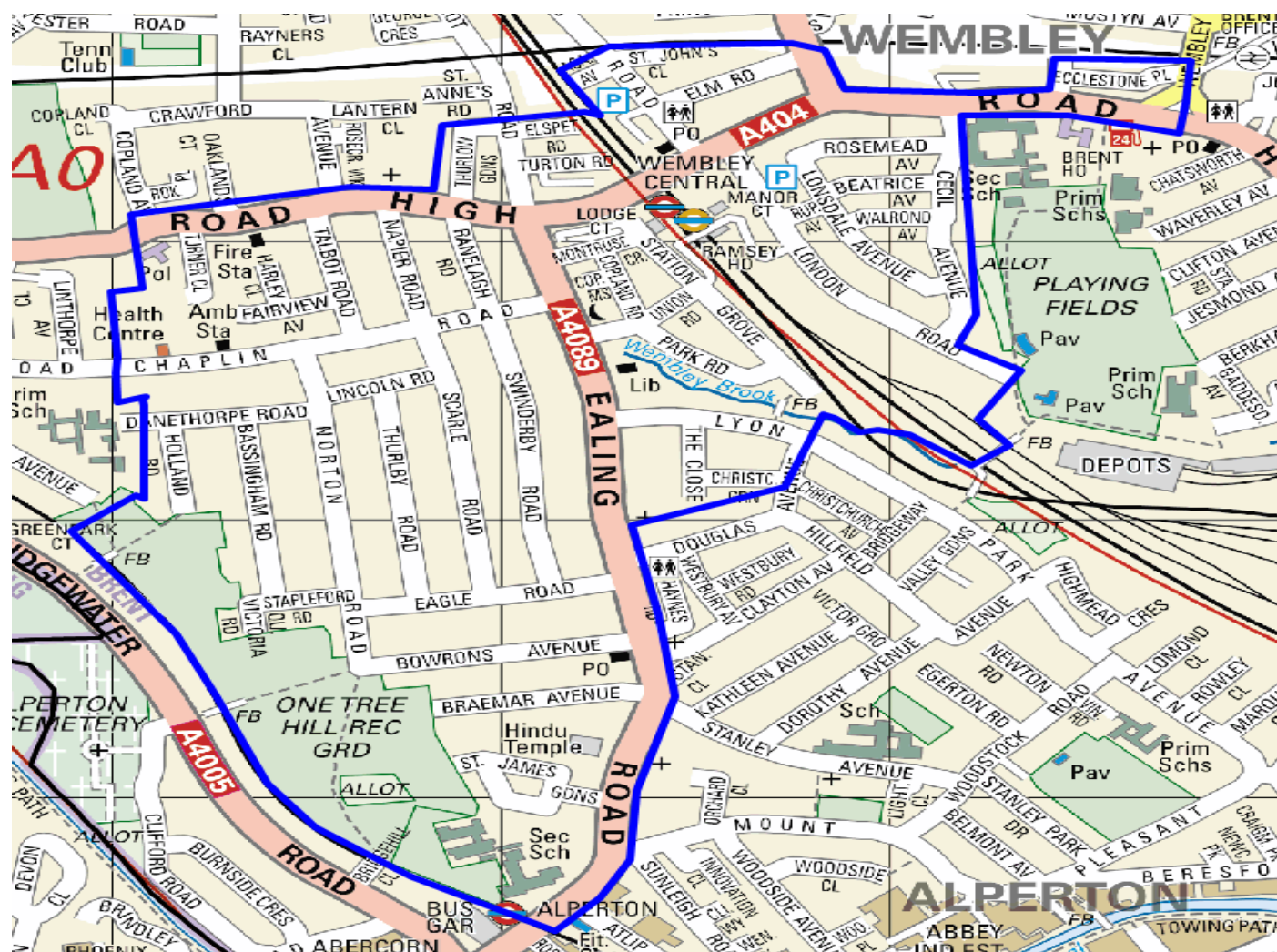
ANTI-SOCIAL CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014
Section 59

Ealing Road Public Spaces Protection Order

The London Borough of Brent, in exercise of its powers under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, will be implementing for a duration of six (6) months a Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO), identifying a Restricted Area (outlined on the map below) where the activities listed under PROHIBITIONS are prohibited and where a Police Officer, Police Community Support Officer (where accredited) or Authorised Council Officers have the power to require persons undertaking any of the restricted actions to cease forthwith.

Restricted Area

From Copland Avenue jct High Road, east bound to jct Thurlow Gardens, north along Thurlow Gardens to jct Elspeth Road continuing across Railtracks, west along St Johns Close to jct High Road, east towards jct Ecclestone Place then north to jct High Road, west along High Road to jct Cecil Avenue, south along Cecil Avenue to jct London Road, heading east over Railtrack to meet Lyon Park Avenue west to meet Ealing Road A4089, north along Ealing Road to jct Bridgewater Road, north along Bridgewater Road continuing over Chaplin Road, continuing north crossing High Road to meet jct Copland Avenue. This includes any roads, open spaces and communal spaces within the mapped outlined area.



Relevant Period

From (time)	0001	hrs (24 hour clock) on	28 April	(year)	2017
To (time)	2359	hrs (24 hour clock) on	27 September	(year)	2017

PROHIBITIONS

Within the area described below, the following is prohibited:-

Alcohol

Any person is prohibited from, at any time, consuming alcohol or having an open alcohol container, in the restricted area

- (i) In this area any person who without reasonable excuse continues consuming alcohol in the restricted area when asked to stop by a Police Officer, Police Community Support Officer or authorised person from the Council under Section 63 of the ASB Crime and Policing Act 2014 or fails to surrender any alcohol in his / her possession when asked to do so by a Police Officer, Police Community Support Officer or authorised person from the Council is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale or if in receipt of a Fixed Penalty Notice to a penalty of a maximum of **£75**.
