Dear Business Licencing Team

I would like to object to the granting of a license to sell alcoholic beverages at the above establishment.

I am a resident of Braemar Avenue [REDACTED]

As I am sure you are aware, we the local residents, have been struggling with the effects of street drinking in this area and are finally making some progress with the help of Brent Council to control and monitor with the application of the Law of the Land the offences of public urination, litter, intimidation and stopping groups of intoxicated men drinking from cans and bottles on the street and in One Tree Park.

Apart from the intimidating atmosphere that is created by our road becoming a 'Pub', the litter (beer cans) and hazards (broken glass, sewage ) that have been a regular hazard of our lives and our children/grandchildren are dangerous and very unsettling.

Many residents have had unpleasant and frightening experiences as a direct result of the uncontrolled supplying of alcohol to people who sadly have no where to go and drink apart from this beautiful residential road and surrounding area.

Granting a licence to sell alcohol to yet another outlet, there are already four in the immediate area, does not seem to support the council's policy (supported by the Metropolitan Police) concerning the eradication at best and controlling at least, of public drunkenness in this residential area of Brent.

I hope the licence is withheld on the grounds that it is not in the residents interest to have a fifth off-license in the space of a half a mile locale.
