Dear Sir/ Madam,

It is with great astonishment that we hear that another potential business on Ealing Road has requested permission to sell alcohol in very close proximity to Sidneys, a premise with which the local community have had continuing problems which are still not fully resolved.

Already the area is blighted by the sight of drinkers using alcohol in the street, threatening our daughters, littering and vomiting, and throwing their cans and bottles wherever they use them. Often we have to call the police when disorderly behaviour occurs in One Tree Hill Open Space and the entrance to the public space at the top of our road. The drinkers have turned the once quiet suburban street into an inner city nightmare.

To consider another licence for another business premises within less than a few hundred meters of the above mentioned premise (Sidneys) will not only bring further problems to the area but greatly increase public disorder, public hygiene and the constant fouling of the street.

Ealing Road has so many alcohol abusers and alcohol providers that to increase capacity for more of this would be indeed very detrimental and it is hard to imagine that a considerate council would even contemplate this. I urge you to not only refuse this application but to consider the current licensing agreements of the premises already in business.

Ealing Road will never improve whilst alcohol is so readily available and the downward spiral of public nuisance (openly urinating, fear and potential harm for frail citizens and gatherings of men drinking and loitering).
