Subject: Consult: variation- The Ruby Lounge (Mezzanine Floor), 1 Popin Commercial Centre, South Way, HA9 0HB

Dear Mr Kirupakaran/ Mr Edge,

RE: Public Health representation for the application to vary the premise licence of 'The Ruby Lounge' Mezzanine Floor, 1 Popin Commercial Centre, South Way HA9 0HB.

The above application has been considered on behalf of the director of Public Health - Dr Melanie Smith, and wish to make a representation as the granting of the application may have a mitigating effect on the licensing objectives: The prevention of crime and disorder, public safety and the prevention of public nuisance.

Based on the above, we propose the following conditions:

Customers shall not be able to take drinks outside of the premises as defined on the plan submitted to and approved by the Licensing Committee.

If the application to vary alcohol sales off the venue refers to an outdoor area as specified above, the outdoor drinking area shall cease at the hour as agreed with the licencing authority.

No sales of full bottles of spirits/wine/champagne. Drinks to be served in plastic or hardened glass.

Hours for licensable activities and re-entry shall not be extended past the hours agreed by the Licencing Committee.

A working ID scanner to be used at all times.

It has been recognised that street drinking and alcohol related incidents are a cause of concern in the Wembley area. As The Ruby Lounge is located within this zone, it is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the variation of the licence will not have a negating impact on licensing objectives in reducing alcohol related harm.

It would be helpful if the applicant could specify how venue procedures will protect against alcohol related public offenses, such as assault and drink-driving.

In addition, please could the applicant specify what steps are being taken to protect the rights of the performers of the dance activities. This includes ensuring the protection from harm or exploitation outside of licensable hours, such as arriving and leaving the venue safely.

If the condition above is accepted in full and confirmed in writing/email, Public Health would withdraw this representation.

We will require this condition to appear on the licence schedule should the licence be granted.
