Please note that I would like to object to the application to vary a premises licence by Wembley Hill Properties Ltd. For St Georges Hotel, Wembley, Middlesex, HA9 8AU.

Being an elderly man who have lived [REDACTED], I have saw the note posed on the wall, only when it was pointed out to me. I would assume that something would have delivered to my door as other neighbours did not know about this today. The note on the wall stated that it was for an external bar and smoking area which directly affects my property. In the past 6-8 weeks upon creation of this external area where previously was car parking space, we have been inconvenienced on event and non event days. Had I known that a building was going to be built with amplified speakers, underground taps and brickwork then I would have objected. I have approached the council and they have found no reference to a planning permission and I do not consider this as a temporary structure. During the time mentioned we have had people shouting, singing an drinking which can be heard till the early morning 1AM / 2AM, I know that some of my neighbours have raised concerns to the extent of calling Brent council noise pollution.
