<i>Brief:</i> Jobcentre plus deliver back to work support for unemployed people in the borough, as well as administer benefits. There are 4 jobcentre plus offices in Brent. Key benefit claims include: Jobseekers Allowance, Employment and Support Allowance, Income Support, Disability Living Allowance and Carers Allowance. Currently, 5.8% (9,920) of the working age population is on Jobseekers Allowance (JSA) a key indicator used by the government to assess unemployment levels, an increase of 8.6% (851) since October 2010.
