M Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General - all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

The premises will operate to a high standard, and will do so should this licence be granted in terms of the sale of alcohol. All staff will be fully trained in their responsibilities with regard to the sale of alcohol, and will be retrained every six months, with recorded training records kept for inspection.

The target audience for this club will be 25 years and above. No one under the age of 21 will be permitted entry to the premises.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

CCTV will be in use at the premises.

The CCTV equipment shall be maintained in good working order and continually record when licensable activity takes place and for a period of two hours afterwards.

The premises licence holder shall ensure images from the CCTV are retained for a period of 31 days. This image retention period may be reviewed as appropriate by the Licensing Authority The correct time and date will be generated onto both the recording and the real time image screen.

If the CCTV equipment (Including any mobile units in use at the premises) breaks down the Premises Licence Holder shall ensure the designated premises supervisor, or in his/her absence other responsible person, verbally informs the Licensing Authority and the Police as soon as is reasonably practicable. This information shall be contemporaneously recorded in the incident report register and shall include the time, date and means this was done and to whom the information was reported. Equipment failures shall be repaired or replaced as soon as is reasonably practicable and without undue delay. The Licensing Authority and the Police shall be informed when faults are rectified.

The premises Licence holder shall ensure that there are trained members of staff available during licensable hours to be able to reproduce and download CCTV images into a removable format at the request of an authorised officer of the Licensing Authority or a Police Licensing Officer.

There shall be clear signage indicating that CCTV equipment is in use and recording at the premises during all trading hours.

The DPS will keep an up to date DPS Authorisation sheet which will show the list of staff members who have been given the authority to sell alcohol on the premises.

A refusals file is kept at the point of sale, and an incident file is kept at the entrance to the premises. Both of these are kept up to date as required, with records of all incidents recorded.

These files will be made available to Licensing officers of the council and police on request.

SIA door staff will be employed at the premises from 22:00 hours until closing time on each night. A risk assessment will be carried out to ascertain how many staff are required on any one evening, and with full consultation with the police.

SIA door staff will also be employed at the Fire Exits, to ensure those who are outside smoking do not cause a nuisance of any kind.

c) Public safety
Staff will be trained to be alert to any potential danger to customers and react accordingly. If they are unable to quickly defuse the situation without risk to customer or staff, then they are instructed to call the police. A full Fire Risk Assessment will be carried out before the premises opens for trade. There are two separate fire escapes leading to a safe back yard area.
d) The prevention of public nuisance
SIA door staff will monitor all potential customers at street level to ensure noise nuisance is not caused by those seeking entry to the club. Anyone leaving the premises in the evenings will be requested to leave in a quiet and orderly manner, by way of instore signage. A dispersal policy will be in place, and is included with this application, with the aim of clearing the area at the end of the night quickly efficiently and without noise nuisance.
e) The protection of children from harm
Only photographic ID is accepted (passport, driving licence, proof of age card with PASS hologram, or Military ID). Anyone who appears to be under the age of 25 is challenged to provide ID. If the customer is unable to provide identification then no sale is made. No ID no sale. All refused sales will be recorded in a refusals book, which will be made available for inspection by Police or Licensing Officers of the council on request. ID checks will be carried out by te door staff, and by the bar staff when customers are requesting alcohol.
