a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

- Staff will be trained regarding appropriate precautions to prevent the sale of alcohol to persons under the age of 18, the signs and symptoms of drunk persons and the refusal of sale due to intoxication. Staff will also be trained to recognise the signs of proxy purchases.
- Electronic records will be kept of such training for the member of staff who
 has received that training.
- All staff will receive refresher training every six months as a minimum and electronic records are to be kept of this refresher training.
- Confirmation of training can be made available to the Licensing Authority or Police within 7 days of a request.
- Any person found to be in breach of the Company alcohol policy is subject to disciplinary proceedings

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- The operators of the premises will maintain a good relationship with the local police and other relevant authorities
- Lidl store management will be trained to view and download CCTV footage
 on receipt of an internal authorisation code. For urgent matters, at all times
 officers will be able to view CCTV footage to verify if a reported offence is
 covered and, whenever required, CCTV will be downloaded and made
 available to the officer as soon as reasonably practicable. For non-urgent
 matters, CCTV will be available to view and download at all times during
 normal office hours on receipt of an internal authorisation code or in any
 event within 48 hours.
- Recordings will be kept for a minimum of 28 days

c) Public safety

- Fire safety equipment is provided at the premises, and staff are trained on the use of this equipment
- Door supervisors/Security Guards will be employed at the premises on occasions as deemed necessary by the Premises Licence Holder following a risk assessment.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

 Alcohol will not be sold in an open container and the consumption of alcohol on the premises will not be permitted

e) The protection of children from harm

There will be a Challenge 25 policy operating at the premises. Challenge 25
means that the holder of the premises licence shall ensure that every

individual, who visually appears to be under 25 years of age and is seeking to purchase or be supplied with alcohol at the premises or from the premises, shall produce identification proving that individual to be 18 years of age or older. Acceptable identification for the purposes of age verification will include a driving licence, passport or photographic identification bearing the "PASS" logo and the person's date of birth. If the person seeking alcohol is unable to produce acceptable means of identification, no sale or supply of alcohol will be made to or for that person.

- In the event that an employee suspects that a person attempting to purchase alcohol is under the age of 25, is a street drinker or is attempting a proxy purchase they will immediately call the duty manager. The duty manager will make appropriate enquiries and will determine whether the sale should be permitted.
- 'Challenge 25' posters shall be displayed in prominent positions at the premises.
- Other than where sold as part of a multipack or gift pack, spirits shall not be sold in bottles of less than 50cl.
- No super-strength beer, lager or cider of 6.5% ABV or above shall be sold at the premises other than speciality/ artisan beer, lager or cider.
- An automated till prompt will be set up so that the operator has to positively confirm that Challenge 25 has been complied with when the first item of alcohol has been scanned.

 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
