This Council agrees the attached budget for 2018/19 with a Council Tax freeze. This proposal means a Brent Council Tax of £1,145.16 at Band D for 2018/19 compared to the Labour proposal for £1,202.31.

The Council notes the following:

- Cumulative Conservative cut in Council Tax since 2014 of 8% against a Labour increase of 13% over the same period.
- Conservative budgets since 2014 would have cost £250 less than Labour over the same period at Band D.
- Scrapping of the hated Green Bin Tax.
- Additional Adult Social Care funding of £2.2m paid for out of Brent Council bank account, not out of bank accounts of Brent residents.
- Council Tax discount for Universal Credit residents.
