(a) From Councillor Arnold

Wembley Developments

Over the next few years we expect to see Wembley transformed. This means additional pressure on environmental and other services. It is important that we plan to support the changes. Although Wembley Wardens are impacting, there is ongoing dissatisfaction, especially about poor and inadequate street cleaning.

What resources are being used and planned to ensure a safe, clean environment in Wembley to support large-scale regeneration?

What initiatives are being developed to ensure that the resident community has real access to new opportunities in relevant areas: business, retail, performance and cultural industries, hospitality, construction etc including developing their own enterprises?
