The Mayor welcomed everyone to the first meeting of the Council over which he was presiding.

#### 1. Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were submitted on behalf of Councillors Mrs N Blackman, Duffin, Gillani, McGovern and C J Patel.

## 2. Declarations of Personal and Prejudicial Interests

Councillor Rands chose to declare a personal interest in the item on 'Proposed Revisions to Brent's Constitution' insofar as it dealt with Members' Allowances.

#### 3. Proposed Revisions to Brent's Constitution

The Borough Solicitor introduced the report which set out a number of proposed changes to the Constitution. These represented the work of the Constitutional Monitoring Group over the last year.

An amendment to the report concerning the Annual Investment Strategy and amending Article 4.2 of the Constitution - Appendix 10 of the report was tabled.

It was pointed out that the current drafting of Standing Order 46, paragraphs (e) and (g) which were replicated in Appendix 2 of the report made incorrect reference to timings and that where it said 20 minutes in paragraph (e) it should say 25 minutes and where it said 10 minutes in paragraph (g) it should say 15 minutes.

Councillor Lorber moved the following six motions which sought:

- (A) To reduce and in some cases delete the amounts paid under Special Responsibility Allowances and Civic Allowances contained within the Members' Allowance Scheme.
- (B) To amend the Constitution to allow for a public question time and presentation of petitions at all meetings of full Council.
- (C) To reduce the number of members required to 'call-in' a decision of the Executive to any 5 non-executive members.
- (D) To abolish the Overview Committee and incorporate its functions into scrutiny thereby avoiding confusion over the roles of scrutiny and overview and simplify the committee structure.
- (E) To establish a Transport Scrutiny Panel of 7 members to monitor and help develop the Council's work in agreeing key

- objectives with transport providers and to bring pressure on service delivery.
- (F) To restrict the Mayor to only attending functions that are of direct benefit to Brent residents, to reduce the cost of the Mayoralty by £50,000 in 2005/05 and a further £50,000 in 2005/06, to end the practice of appointing a Deputy Mayor and to develop a code of conduct and duties for the role of the Mayor.

Councillor D Long moved a procedural motion that all the above motions be voted upon en-bloc which was CARRIED.

The view was expressed that to move motions of such significance to the Council's Constitution at such a late stage was unreasonable and that these proposals should have first been submitted to the Constitutional Monitoring Group for discussion. It was noted that although the Constitutional Monitoring Group was a cross-party group, no Liberal Democrat Councillors had attended the meetings during the last year.

The motions tabled and moved by Councillor Lorber were put to the vote and LOST.

#### **RESOLVED:-**

- (i) that the motions tabled in the name of Councillor Lorber be voted upon en-bloc;
- (ii) that the proposed future monitoring of the Executive arrangements, as outlined in paragraph 6.2 of the report, be noted;
- (iii) that the changes already made to the Constitution by Full Council since 19<sup>th</sup> May 2003 be noted;
- (iv) that the changes to Standing Orders made by the Borough Solicitor under her delegated powers since 19<sup>th</sup> May 2003 summarised at Appendix 1 and shown as tracked changes at Appendix 2 of the report be approved;
- (v) that the changes to the Constitution shown at Appendices 3 to 21 of the report be agreed.

(In accordance with Standing Order 48(d), Councillor Rands required his abstention in the votes on the motions submitted by Councillor Lorber and on resolution (i) to be recorded).

#### 4. **Review of Representation of Political Groups on Committees**

The Council had before it a report which dealt with the rules to be applied on the allocation of seats on the committees to be established by the Council to political groups.
