Councillor Sengupta

The Council stood in silence for one minute in memory of Councillor Sengupta who had died suddenly on 28th April 2005. The Mayor explained that fuller tributes would be paid to Councillor Sengupta at the meeting of Council on 16th May.

1. Election of Mayor

The Worshipful the Mayor (Councillor Shahzad) welcomed all Members present. He then called for nominations for the office of the Mayor of the Borough for the municipal year 2005/2006.

Councillor John nominated Councillor Moloney and was seconded by Councillor Moher. Councillor Rands nominated Councillor Fiegel and was seconded by Councillor R Blackman. A vote was thereupon taken, 33 Members voted for Councillor Moloney and 17 Members voted for Councillor Fiegel.

RESOLVED:

that Councillor Moloney be, and he is hereby elected, Mayor of the London Borough of Brent, for the municipal year 2005/2006.

Councillor Shahzad then invested the Mayor with the Mayoral Chain and Badge of Office, and invested the new Mayoress with her Badge of Office. Councillor Shahzad thereupon vacated the Chair which was taken by the newly elected Mayor.

Councillor Moloney read and signed the statutory declaration of acceptance of office of Mayor.

The Mayor then thanked Members of the Council for his election and addressed the Council.

The Mayor informed the Council that his charities for the year would be the Brent Irish Advisory Service and the Paul Daisley Trust.

The Mayor then invited Councillor Lyon to move the following motion which was seconded by Councillor HB Patel.

that the Council place on record their thanks and regard for the outstanding public service rendered by the co-opted members, independent members, observers and others who have served on Council Committees, Sub-Committees, Consultative Committees, Boards, Governing Bodies, etc during the past municipal year.

The Council also appreciates his attendance at a vast number of community events and functions and his service to all sections of Brent's diverse community.

The Mayor invested Councillor Shahzad with the past Mayor's Badge and the Mayoress invested the retiring Mayor's Consort with the past Mayor's Consort Badge.

Councillor Shahzad returned thanks, reviewed his year of office and thanked staff, colleagues and his son for the support that he had received during his term.

3. **Appointment of Deputy Mayor**

The Mayor informed the Council that he had appointed Councillor Gladbaum to be Deputy Mayor of the London Borough of Brent for the municipal year 2005/2006. The Deputy Mayor having taken her place on the rostrum was invested by the Mayor with her Chain and Badge of Office. The Deputy Mayor's Consort having taken her place on the rostrum was invested by the Mayoress with her Chain and Badge of Office.
