## 1. Election of Mayor

The Worshipful the Mayor (Councillor Moloney) welcomed all Members present. He then called for nominations for the office of the Mayor of the Borough for the municipal year 2006/2007.

Councillor Wharton nominated Councillor C J Patel and was seconded by Councillor Anwar. Councillor John nominated Councillor Joseph and was seconded by Councillor Blackman. A vote was thereupon taken, 25 Members voted for Councillor C J Patel and 36 Members voted for Councillor Joseph.

#### RESOLVED:

that Councillor Joseph be, and she is hereby elected, Mayor of the London Borough of Brent, for the municipal year 2006/2007.

Councillor Joseph signed the statutory declaration of acceptance of office of Mayor.

Councillor Moloney then invested the Mayor with the Mayoral Chain and Badge of Office, and invested the new Mayor's consort with his Badge of Office. Councillor Moloney thereupon vacated the Chair which was taken by the newly elected Mayor.

The Mayor then thanked Members of the Council for her election and addressed the Council.

The Mayor informed the Council that her charities for the year would be the Down's Syndrome Association and a Children's Hospice.

The Mayor then moved the following motion:

that the Council place on record their thanks and regard for the outstanding public service rendered by the co-opted members, independent members, observers and others who have served on council committees, sub-committees, consultative committees, boards, governing bodies, etc during the past municipal year.

### 2. Vote of Thanks to the Retiring Mayor

Councillor John moved a vote of thanks to the retiring Mayor for his services to the community. Members paid tribute to the work of Councillor Moloney during his year as Mayor.

#### RESOLVED:

that the Council records its appreciation of the outstanding service rendered by Councillor Moloney as Mayor of the London Borough of Brent during the past municipal year and for the manner in which he has presided over Council meetings. The Council also appreciates his attendance at a vast number of community events and functions and his service to all sections of Brent's diverse community.

The Mayor then invested Councillor Moloney with the past Mayor's Badge and the Mayor's Consort invested the retiring Mayoress with the past Mayoress' Badge.

Councillor Moloney returned thanks, reviewed his year of office and thanked staff, colleagues and his family for the support that he had received during his term.

# 3. Appointment of Deputy Mayor

The Mayor informed the Council that she had appointed Councillor H B Patel to be Deputy Mayor of the London Borough of Brent for the municipal year 2006/2007. The Deputy Mayor having taken his place on the dais was invested by the Mayor with his Chain and Badge of Office. The Deputy Mayoress having taken her place on the rostrum was invested by the Mayor's Consort with her Chain and Badge of Office.
