REPORT FROM THE EXECUTIVE

1. Items to be reported by the Executive

The Leader has given notice that the Executive will report to Council on the following items:

- i) Brent PCT Update
- ii) School places
- iii) Tornado Appeal
- iv) Housing Benefit Subsidy cuts
- v) Wembley Stadium
- vi) Library funding

2. Decisions taken by the Executive under the Council's urgency provisions

Under the provisions of rule 38 of the Access to Information Rules in the Constitution, the Executive is required to report to the next Full Council for information on any key decisions taken by them but which did not appear in the Forward Plan.

Petition from residents of Chamberlayne Avenue/Edison Drive

The above item was considered by the Executive (Highways Committee) on 6th December 2006.

Decision taken:

- (i) that a feasibility study be undertaken into the possibility of funding and introducing a temporary gating of the walking/cycling link, including consultation with the police

concerning possible closure times and reported to a future Committee meeting; and

- (ii) that the petitioners and other residents be advised of the Committee's decisions.

Reason why it was impractical to defer the decision until it could be included on the Forward Plan:

A decision is required because Members and residents wanted an urgent decision because of the fear of crime.
