Memorial to Brent resident

This Council remembers the tragic and senseless murder of local lawyer and Brent resident Tom Ap Rhys Pryce on Bathurst Gardens in March, 2006 as he walked home from Kensal Green Station.

This Council supports the idea raised by local ward councillor Bertha Joseph, a former neighbour of Mr Ap Rhys Pryce of planting of a tree in Kensal Green in remembrance of him.

This tree would be planted in College Road, Kensal Green, at a place in-between his home and Kensal Green Station that he would have passed on his way home.

The Council agrees that provision should be made for a plaque to be installed at the same spot also dedicated to his memory.

This Council also notes that the planting of the tree has been raised with the family of Mr Ap Rhys Pryce and his fiancé Adele Eastman and also with the Tom Ap Rhys Pryce Trust where it was both welcomed and agreed.
