The following petition has been verified by Democratic Services and contains in excess of 50 signatures:-

- **Preston Road / East Lane Junction**

This petition, submitted by Councillor R Dunwell on behalf of local traders and residents, stating that:

“We, the undersigned, traders and residents deplore the fact that the London Borough of Brent’s present proposed “London Bus Priority” scheme for the above junction only partly addresses our concerns as it still is most likely to deprive the traders of livelihood and residents of amenities and convenience. Furthermore, we require that the scheme be redrawn to include a long goods vehicle loading bay and car parking. That there be no metered parking or pay and display. That a “1or 2 hour free parking regime scheme” be introduced as per elsewhere in Preston Road and on pavement parking to be continued down Preston Road northwards beyond No.19 Preston Road. In addition it is confirmed that Mr R Dunwell be authorised to represent the petitioners on this issue and related matters.”
