

Zone G - Pay & Display Scheme Review

BACKGROUND

The Pay and Display scheme operating in Willesden High Road / Walm lane area was originally introduced in 2000 following a consultation with the local community. The scheme was implemented to:

- Remove commuter and long-term non-residential parking in the High Street
- Improve road safety by removing obstructive parking from junctions
- . To reduce the level of traffic in the area by regulating parking on-street
- To attract more customers to local businesses by allowing greater turnover of allocated parking spaces

Brent Council is now carrying out a review of the Pay and Display scheme to ascertain whether any improvements can be made to the parking, waiting and loading and road safety for all road users. 
