8th February 2007	Review the Online Consultation Pilot	<p>The consultation team acquired SNAP on-line consultation software in early 2004 as part of a WLA e.govt project. More recently we have developed 'Consultation Tracker' our on-line consultation database. We have also, (this year), recruited another Citizens' Panel.</p> <p>Although we have completed ten on-line consultations, we recognise that SNAP has a number of inherent problems that we have been unable to resolve.</p> <p>Many local authorities have gone for an overall IT solution and we have been looking at a number of suppliers. We were awarded some money from the CE's Performance Fund and we are likely to purchase an external software solution called Citizen Space Local. This service would enable us to link:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • More effective on-line consultations • A more interactive database of consultation • Continuous on-line recruitment for the Citizens' Panel • The creation of a separate e-consultation panel for Brent. <p>We only have money for this for one year - so the fundamental aspect of this pilot project is will it prove its worth and attract future mainstream funding?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review of pilot and how it is functioning • Identify opportunities for further development • Make recommendations on mainstreaming this aspect of Brent's consultation programme
