# **Area and Service User Forums and Consultation Update**

## 1. Summary

- 1.1 This report outlines key issues and trends across area and service user consultative forums, which took place during the third meetings cycle of 2006-07.

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#### 3. Detail

- 3.1 The Chair of the Private Sector SUCF had requested that an update on the delay of Home Multiple Occupation Licensing be presented to the Overview and Scrutiny Committee. The issues are set out in detail in a separate report which will be presented at a future Overview and Scrutiny Committee.
- 3.2 There are no other issues from area or service user consultative forums.
- 3.3 The 2006/07 BVPI General Survey was finalised in mid March 2007. The overall satisfaction level for the Council has risen four points to 52%. The survey also showed some encouraging results on environmental performance indicators with eleven of the thirteen PI's showing improvement over the 2003 survey. Full results can be downloaded from the consultation tracker at: www.brent.gov.uk/consultation Results of the other BVPI surveys, planning, revenues and benefits, libraries and tenants, are currently being finalised and will be available for download from the consultation tracker site.
- 3.4 An inaugural pre-meeting of the Brent youth parliament took place on Friday 9th March in the national parliament annexe, Portcullis House. The meeting was hosted by South Brent MP, Dawn Butler and fortyseven young people from across the borough were in attendance. The participants discussed and prioritised a range of future issues for the youth parliament and were able to put questions to the MP and the youth parliament co-chair as well as the director and executive member for the Children and Families service area. A formal launch of the youth parliament is scheduled to take place on 9<sup>th</sup> Jun 2007 at Brent Town Hall.
- 3.5 A new Brent citizens' panel has been recruited. The new panel stands at just over 1,600 members. The panel was recruited over a six month period, principally from opinion and satisfaction surveys together with an ad hoc postcard recruitment drive targeted at people in the younger age ranges. The citizens' panel has already been used as part of the regional casino consultation and for running focus groups on environmental

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health and methods of budget consultation. Future panel work includes; a joint Council / PCT survey on health priorities and a survey on the council's street tree policy as well as some parks service non-user focus groups.

3.6 The Consultation Team have recently bought into 'Consultation Portal', an on-line suite of consultation and database tools created by BMG systems, a Birmingham based IT consultancy company. The purchase was funded by money obtained through the Chief Executive's performance fund. The Consultation Portal will enable us to improve our current consultation database, Consultation Tracker, as well as providing additional facilities such as, on-line surveys, on-line focus group and bulletin boards. The Consultation Portal will also allow for improved management of the work of the citizens' panel by maintaining a system of continuous recruitment, the setting up of a separate e.panel and the creation of an e.mail system to alert panel members to forthcoming consultations.
