REPORT TITLE: DECLARATIONS IN THE REGISTER OF GIFTS AND HOSPITALITY

1.0 SUMMARY

This report informs members on the declarations of interest and declarations of gifts and hospitality made in the period since the last Monitoring Officer's report in July 2004, in accordance with a recent recommendation from the Head of Audit and Investigation.

2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

That members note the report.

3.0 DETAIL

Members will recall the audit findings which were reported to the Standards Committee at its January meeting. The audit was undertaken as part of the 2004-05 internal audit plan. The report from the auditors identified a number of failures to register gifts and hospitality. It recommended some steps to be taken to rectify non-compliances and improve the situation in the future. One recommendation was that the Monitoring Officer give a 6 monthly report on the entries into the Register of Gifts and Hospitality which is met by this report. The declarations made since July 2004 are listed in Appendix 1 . The table lists all entries received regardless of whether they are inside or outside the £25 rule.

4.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no financial implications.

5.0 LEGAL IMPLICATIONS

The Brent Code of Conduct requires that members, within 28 days of receiving any gift or hospitality over the value of £25, provide written notification to the authority's Monitoring Officer of the existence and nature of that gift or hospitality. Failure to do so is a breach of the code and risks being referred to the Standards Board for England.

6.0 DIVERSITY IMPLICATIONS

Officers believe that there are no specific diversity implications in this report.
