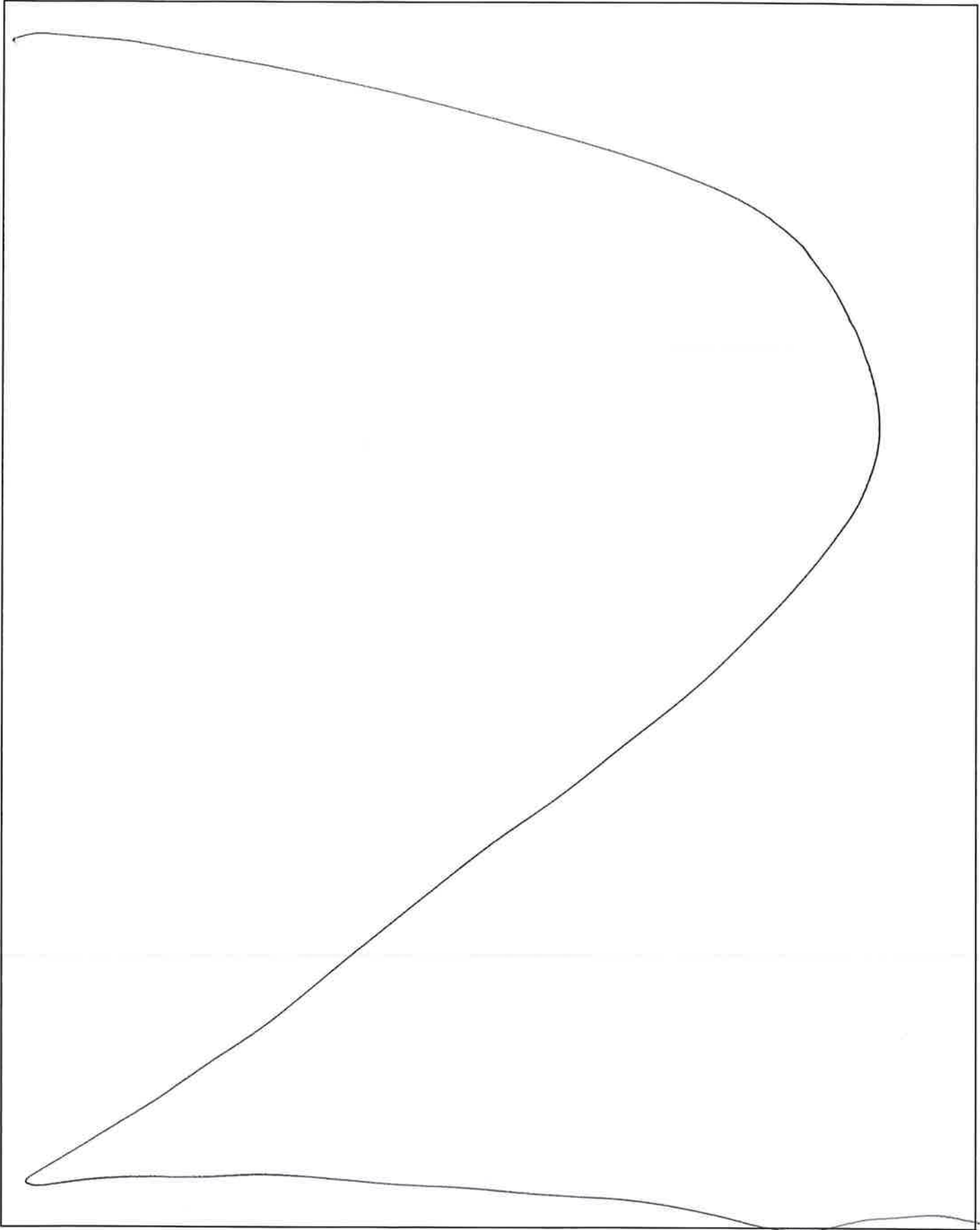

I am a PCSO Charles Charalambous a community support officer currently attached to the NORTHWICK Park Safer Neighbourhood Team based at Wembley police Station. My shoulder number is 7271QK. I have been employed in this role as a PCSO since September 2007. . On WEDNESDAY 24TH AUGUST 2016 I was driving to work at approx. 7.20am in the morning I was driving over the bridge at NORTH WEMBLEY STN when I stopped at the lights EAST LANE jctn HARROWDENE rd. I looked to my left when I noticed three (3) people sitting on the floor outside the EASTERN EUROPEAN DELI 189 East Lane. I clearly saw one (1) Male drinking lager from a can the other male and lady who I recognised works at the shop where drinking what appeared to be hot drinks. I turned the corner and parked my car and walked around the corner with my police staff i. D in hand, I spoke to the lady who works there who was sitting on the floor and said " I THOUGHT YOU TOLD ME THAT YOU DON'T ALLOW PEOPLE DRINKING OUTSIDE YOUR SHOP" she looked shocked and stated she didn't I pointed to the gentleman sitting One (1) yard to her right who was clearly drinking lager , the lady spoke in Romanian to the gentleman and he apologised and went and put the lager in the bin. She apologised and I walked back to my car and drove to work. I then spoke to SGT CRYAN and told him what I have witnessed.

We have had a lot of complaints regarding the DELI I have constantly seen what appears to be a meeting place for workers gathering therefore we have constantly spoken to them regarding the issues and the cans of lager behind their premises.
