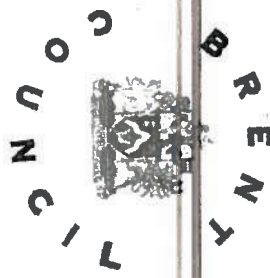

I would like to confirm that I have considered the above proposal with regard to the prevention of public nuisance. On behalf of the (Safer Streets) Environmental Health I OBJECT to the application on the following grounds:

1. That the proposed operating hours are inappropriate due to the close proximity of residential dwellings.
2. The noise caused by patrons exiting the premises, particularly with respect to door management and dispersal of patrons, and appropriate arrangements for securing suitable transport home is likely to be detrimental to the residential amenity. It is my understanding that you intend to cater for 220 patrons rather than the 100 stated in your application.
3. There is no operating schedule addressing how the applicant will promote the prevention of public nuisance from regulated entertainment.
4. The premises is not capable of containing regulated entertainment noise

Supporting Information

Safer Streets inspected the premises in 2010 and established that the fabric of the building; especially the windows, doors and roof covering was unsuitable to prevent noise egress, especially from amplified music and entertainment. Despite our recommendation to the operators to upgrade acoustic weak-spots no sound insulation works have been undertaken.

Safer Streets continues to receive complaints of noise disturbance from amplified music at this venue. We are in on-going dialogue with the operators to take action to prevent further nuisance from use of the venue for amplified entertainment and await confirmation of the date sound insulation works will commence.

Dear Mr Robbin-Coker

Thank you for your email and the additional information provided. This does not change the fundamental reason for my objection, namely my concerns regarding noise nuisance and the potential impact on local residents. As a result I will not be withdrawing my objection to the event.

I can appreciate that this is frustrating for you in light of the arrangements you have made to organise this. As you were advised our recent conversation you will still have the opportunity to have the issues you raised considered by the Licensing Committee who will make the final decision on whether you are granted a licence.

The next hearing is scheduled for Wednesday 12th December 2012 in Brent Town Hall Chambers at 7pm. Further details regarding the arrangements for this will be forwarded to you in due course.

Thank you very much for your e-mail correspondence of 6/12/12.

The Licence applied for is on behalf of The Leone Association holding their 31st Annual Pre-Xmas fund raising dinner & dance. The Leone Association (Motto: Originate & Emulate All Good Things), whose main objectives are honourable and charitable i.e. (1) to promote education and health (2) to relieve poverty and sickness. Proceeds from this event (as from past events) go to charity e.g. blind school, sickle cell anaemia, diabetes, etc etc.

The organisation has always conducted its business with dignity, decorum, consideration for all concerned and compliance with all relevant dictates. The Granville Plus Centre was hired in September - deposit paid and final payment made since October from which time we have been making all necessary arrangements/preparations such as inviting of guests and catering plans.

The following conditions were highlighted (a) that the guests should use the Carlton Vale entrance (b) that in order to keep the noise level within acceptable and regulated constraints, a noise limiter has been installed (c) that guests entering and leaving should do so with minimum noise so as not to disturb neighbours (d) security arrangements should be put in place.

We intend to adhere and comply as we have always done in the past in various halls in all boroughs. The concerns expressed in your letter are points which have always been taken into

consideration and addressed successfully.
