Police Objection to the Temporary Event Notice for Chamberlayne, 83 Chamberlayne Road, NW10 3ND

I certify that I have considered the notice shown above and I wish to make representations that the use of the premises for the temporary event would undermine the crime prevention initiative, for the reasons indicated below.

An officer of the Metropolitan Police, in whose area the premises are situated, who is authorised for the purposes of exercising its statutory function as a 'Responsible Authority' under the Licensing Act 2003.

A Temporary Event Notice has been given under section 100 Licensing Act 2003 by Mr Robert CLAASEN received in this office on the 10th August 2013.

Police are formally objecting to the notice under section 104 Licensing Act 2003. The Police objection is primarily concerned with the crime and disorder and public safety objectives:

The application is to host a "carnival event", no further details are given.

A police form 696 event risk assessment form has not been provided for the event.

This event falls on the August Bank Holiday Sunday and may obviously impact upon the Notting Hill Carnival which draws large numbers to the area. The times are late and cover the post carnival period where previously there has been sporadic disorder in Chamberlayne Road. This premises has also come to note in previous years at carnival for hosting large crowds whicl parie in to the street and a lack of supervision

in relation to this. Until the applicant supplies further information about the details of this event and I have completed the subsequent necessary checks I fear that if it is allowed to go ahead that there will be an increased risk of crime and disorder at the location, which may impact upon all of the licensing objectives.

I certify that I have considered the notice shown above and I wish to make representations that the use of the premises for the temporary event would undermine the crime prevention initiative, for the reasons indicated below.

An officer of the Metropolitan Police, in whose area the premises are situated, who is authorised for the purposes of exercising its statutory function as a 'Responsible Authority' under the Licensing Act 2003.

A Temporary Event Notice has been given under section 100 Licensing Act 2003 by Mr Luke ALLEN received in this office on the 10th August 2013.

Police are formally objecting to the notice under section 104 Licensing Act 2003. The Police objection is primarily concerned with the crime and disorder and public safety objectives:

The application is to host a "carnival event", no further details are given.

A police form 696 event risk assessment form has not been provided for the event.

This event falls on the August Bank Holiday Sunday and may obviously impact upon the Notting Hill Carnival which draws large numbers to the area. The times are late and cover the post carnival period where previously there has been sporadic disorder in Chamberlayne Road. This premises has also come to note in previous years at carnival for hosting large crowds whith a greil in to the street and a notable lack of

supervision. Until the applicant supplies further information about the details of this event and I have completed the subsequent necessary checks I fear that if it is allowed to go ahead that there will be an increased risk of crime and disorder at the location, which may impact upon all of the licensing objectives.
