- Suspend the licence for a period not exceeding 3 months
- Revoke the licence

If the Committee find no steps are necessary to meet the licensing objectives they may decide not to take any action or to issue a warning.

### Annexe 1 - Mandatory Conditions

- (a) No supply of alcohol may be made at a time when no designated premises supervisor has been specified in the licence or at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his or her licence has been suspended.
- (b) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- (c) All persons present on the premises who are required to carry out a security activity must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (d) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
- (e) The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
- (f) The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
- (g) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- (h) The responsible person shall ensure that-
- (i) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-
- beer or cider: half pint;
  - gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25ml or 35ml; and
  - still wine in a glass: 125ml; and
- (ii) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

### **Annexe 2 - Conditions Consistent With the Operating Schedule**

1. CCTV shall be installed and maintained in a working condition.
2. All CCTV recordings shall be kept for 31 days and shall be made available to police and licensing officers if requested.
3. Customers shall not be permitted to take open glass containers outside the premises as defined on the plan submitted to and approved by the Licensing Authority.
4. A copy of the premises licence summary including the hours which licensable activities are permitted shall be visible from the outside of each entrance to the premises.
5. No entry or re-entry shall be permitted after 02:30 hours.
6. The total number of people permitted on the premises including staff and performers shall not exceed 50.

### **Annexe 3 - Conditions Attached After a Hearing by the Licensing Authority**

At all times when amplified live or recorded music or voice are being played at the premises all doors and windows must remain closed.

From 00:00, up to and including closing time Monday to Sunday, an employee of the applicant must supervise the exit of every person from the premises, and ensure and instruct each person to leave quietly and not congregate outside the front of the premises.

I certify that I have considered the notice shown above and **I wish to make representations** that the use of the premises for the temporary event would undermine the crime prevention initiative, for the reasons indicated below.

An authorised officer of the Metropolitan Police, in whose area the premises are situated, for the purposes of exercising its statutory function as a 'Responsible Authority' under the Licensing Act 2003.

A Temporary Event Notice has been given under section 100 Licensing Act 2003 by Mr T'jae Joscelyn Ellis, received in this office on Friday 30th January 2015. Police are formally objecting to the notice under section 104 Licensing Act 2003. The Police objection is concerned with the crime and disorder, public safety and public nuisance objectives.

The notices is to allow for the use of the premises for a Valentines party for 400 persons from 2200 to 0500, the licensable activities are the sale of alcohol, provision of late night refreshment and regulated entertainment.

The purpose of this objection is to give the applicant the opportunity to furnish the relevant authority with a Form 696 Risk Assessment in relation to this event. This is to include the proposed details of the event and should include detailed security plans, genre of music, and how the event is to be advertised.

The reason for this is there is no licence for this premise and therefore no existing conditions.

I will contact the applicant in the near future to see if this matter may be resolved prior to a council hearing.

I would like to confirm that I have considered the above proposal with regard to the prevention of public nuisance.

On behalf of Regulatory Services (Environmental Health) I would like to Make representations to the T.E.N.

On the following grounds:

That the proposed operating hours are inappropriate due to the close proximity of residential dwellings. The noise caused by patrons exiting the premises and finding suitable transport home is likely to be detrimental to the residential amenity.

The operating schedule does not address the prevention of public nuisance from:

- airborne entertainment noise
- Noise generated by patrons in external areas of the premises e.g. Smoking Area
- Noise generated from patrons queuing to enter
- Noise from patrons exiting the premises

If this T.E.N is to be granted I propose the following conditions.

### **Conditions**

1. The Applicant/Licensee shall ensure that amplified/Live music played in the licensed premises is **Not Audible** at or within the site boundary of any residential property in the surrounding area. No speakers are to be located in any external areas.
2. The Applicant/Licensee shall appoint a member of Staff/Door supervisor to monitor the door(s) leading to external areas, and keep them closed and not propped open. The appointed member shall also encourage/usher patrons that has finished smoking back inside the property.
3. Signs shall be erected in external areas telling patrons to keep voices down, and respect the local residents.
4. Door supervisors shall be employed, and encourage patrons to leave quietly and prevent people from congregating outside the premises once the event has finished.

### **Supporting Information**

A noise abatement notice has been served on the applicant dated 06/12/2013.  
The last recorded complaint was received on 15/05/2014.

**Other Comments**

The Nuisance Control Team will actively investigate any noise complaints received during the event. If the noise is witnessed at a nuisance level, a breach of the noise abatement notice will be sent to the Licensee.

Subsequent breach of the notice will result in prosecution.

The Licensee is reminded that persistent noise complaints may provide grounds for a licence review and may jeopardise approval of future TEN applications.

This TEN application will only be approved if the Licensee agrees to abide by the conditions outlined above.
