In addition, the concerns raised were not considered serious enough to merit any changes to the premises licence. It was noted that the resident requesting the review had again failed to attend the hearing that had been arranged to consider his request and neither had any effort been made on his part to respond to attempts by the premises licence holder and their representatives to discuss addressing the concerns that he had raised. Accordingly, with the above factors in mind, the sub-committee determined that the premises licence remain in force and no further action be taken. |
