A5	Application by Local Food Express to vary the designated premises supervisor for 'Local Food Express' (16 Park Parade, London, NW10 4JH) pursuant to the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003	that the application by Local Food Express to vary the designated supervisor for 'Local Food Express' (16 Park Parade, London, NW10 4JH) pursuant to the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 be <b>refused.</b> The Alcohol and Entertainment Licensing Sub-Committee (B) felt that as the proposed designated premises supervisor (DPS) lived in Leeds, it would significantly affect his ability to perform this role at his premises in London. The sub-committee also heard evidence from the applicant that inferred that he had been acting outside the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003, namely that the premises had been operating without either a DPS or a personal licence holder. It was noted that the applicant had committed a relevant offence in respect of prevention of crime and disorder and this was accordingly taken into account. The sub-committee further considered that the granting of the application would undermine the council's licensing objective with regard to prevention of crime and disorder. In view of the above reasons, the sub-committee accordingly refused the application.  The sub-committee added an informative advising the applicant that he seek proper advice in progressing this application.
