I certify that I have considered the notice shown above and I wish to make representations that the use of the premises for the temporary event would undermine the crime prevention initiative, for the reasons indicated below.

A licensing officer of the Metropolitan Police, in whose area the premises are situated, who is authorised for the purposes of exercising its statutory function as a 'Responsible Authority' under the Licensing Act 2003.

A Temporary Event Notice have been given under section 100 Licensing Act 2003 by Ms Wendy Jones, received in this office on Tuesday 14th May 2013.

Police are formally objecting to the notices under section 104 Licensing Act 2003. The Police objection is primarily concerned with the crime and disorder and public safety objectives:

The notices are to allow for the extended use of the premises from 0000 to 0700 the next day. The licensable activities are the sale of alcohol, late night refreshment and regulated entertainment .

The purpose of this objection is to give the applicant the opportunity to furnish the relevant authority with a Form 696 Risk Assessment in relation to this event. This is to include the details of the promoters and DJ's that will play at this event and should include detailed security plans.

I will contact the applicant in the near future to see if this matter may be resolved prior to a council hearing.

As per my telephone call just now I am making an <u>objection</u> to your application based on concerns that the event has potential to cause a public nuisance.

That is not to say the event cannot go ahead .My biggest concern is that the venue is in relatively close proximity to residential housing and the event is planned to run throughout the night until 7am. If you can agree to Conditions which will control the potential noise that may arise from this event then it maybe possible to withdraw the objection. My main concern however is the event terminal hour been 7am.

You said you had heard from Nick Mortimer from the Police (Licensing) and you were to provide him with details of Security and the sound.

I would like you to specify whether you will be using an in-house music system, or providing your own, or even hiring a music system.

I would also like you to specify what the equipment is (ie, CD mixer / turntables / amplifier / bass box / speakers) with specific focus on the equipment make and model and especially the power output in Watts of any amplifier/s and speakers. Can you please provide that asap.

If you can also give me details of how you intend to ensure that noise from amplified music, from guests being outside and from guests leaving the event will not cause a nuisance to nearby neighbours that would be a good start.

Please don't hesitate to come back to me if you need any assistance.
