

Police are formally making representations to the notice under section 104 Licensing Act 2003. The Police objection is primarily concerned with the crime and disorder and prevention of public nuisance objectives.

The application is for extension of authority for music and entertainment from 2300 hours on Sunday 24th August to 0200 hours on Monday 25th August 2014.

The current premises licence for the venue on Sunday nights permits live and recorded music until 2300 hours, sale of alcohol until 2330 hours and close to the public at midnight. However there are **Non Standard timings** on Notting Hill Carnival Sunday and Monday until 0200 hours for the supply of alcohol ONLY, closing to the public at 0230 hours.

The reason that the Non standard timings does not include live or recorded music is because this premises is located in the heart of a residential area.

Police object to live or recorded music at this venue after the times stipulated on the premises licence.

I have been employed as a licensing officer on the borough since 2005, my duties include annual enforcement and inspection of licensed premises during the Notting Hill Carnival august bank holiday weekend.

Since 2012 there have been no issues during the bank holiday weekend, this is because the venue has not played amplified music in excess of the premises licence. Temporary event notices were not submitted for 2011, 2012 or 2013.

In 2010 a local resident complained to Police that during carnival weekend she was disturbed until 3am on both days by music and verbal noise from customers of The Island had spilled in to the street.

In 2009 complaints from local residents were received and the local authority Noise Team issued a noise abatement order.

If this TEN is honoured Police believe the noise and nuisance would be excessive, there would be issues with crowd control and dispersal. Condition 16 of the premises licence requests a risk assessment should be furnished to Police prior to any promoted event. The DPS has indicated this would be a ticketed event however a risk assessment has not been supplied to alleviate any concerns.

Notting Hill carnival is Europe's biggest street carnival, celebrating London's cultural diversity and attracts visitors from all over the world. This popularity brings huge challengers for the Police and local authorities in managing the event to ensure that it is safe and as trouble free as we can make it. In order to achieve this we rely on those who operate licensed premises to identify and manage any additional risks that carnival presents. This premise is located in Harlesden where historically crime and disorder has occurred during the evenings of that weekend. Harlesden is one of the main arterial routes in to carnival and this venue is close to Willesden Junction station. Late licensed venues in

Harlesden on the bank holiday Monday does nothing to promote the licensing objectives and from experience of Policing this area of Brent during Carnival since 2005, most licensed premises chose to close earlier on the Monday night. In the past years the irresponsible supply of alcohol has had a negative impact on carnival visitors with the local community bearing the brunt of the antisocial fallout.

During the recent Football world cup Police received complaints from local residents with regard the amount of noise emanating from the premises including sound from a television, music, doors and windows wide open. Cad 30/26th July refers. Also see the attached flyer.

Police suggest the premises close to the public at 2300 hours on Monday 25th August 2014.

With regard to the remainder of the notification in order to assist Police and local authority in managing an orderly and safe close down of the carnival on both Sunday and Monday, any external areas are not to be used after 1800 hours. After 1800 hours all windows and doors to remain closed whilst licensable activity is taking place at the venue. The external areas can be used for customers to smoke only (no drinking vessels to be taken out).

Police request the current conditions attached to the premises licence be adhered to on both Sunday 24th and Monday 25th August 2014, in addition to the following conditions:

Door supervisors of a suitable gender mix, shall be employed whilst the venue is open to the public.

A register/log containing the names, badge number, dates & times of duty of security staff and any incidents that occur shall be kept and made available to the Police and Licensing Authority.

Door supervisors shall wear clothing that can be clearly and easily identified on CCTV.

CCTV shall be installed to Home Office Guidance standards and maintained in a good working condition and recordings shall be kept for 31 days and shall be made available to police and authorised Officers from Brent Council.

No drinks shall be served other than in plastic or toughened glasses.

A "Challenge 21" policy shall be adopted and adhered to.

Customers carrying open or sealed bottles or glasses shall not be admitted to the premises.

I certify that I have considered the notice shown above and I wish to make representations that the use of the premises for the temporary event would undermine the crime prevention initiative, for the reasons indicated below.

An officer of the Metropolitan Police, in whose area the premises are situated, who is authorised for the purposes of exercising its statutory function as a 'Responsible Authority' under the Licensing Act 2003.

A Temporary Event Notice has been given under section 100 Licensing Act 2003 by Miss Beverley Currie.

Police are formally making representations to the notice under section 104 Licensing Act 2003. The Police objection is primarily concerned with the crime and disorder and prevention of public nuisance objectives.

The application is for provision of regulated entertainment, and on and off sales of alcohol during Notting Hill Carnival, Sunday 24th and Monday 25th August 2014 from 1200 - 2000 hours.

Police are objecting to the Off Sales of alcohol and external positioning of the amplified speakers on these days.

Notting Hill carnival is Europe's biggest street carnival, celebrating London's cultural diversity and attracts visitors from all over the world. This popularity brings huge challengers for the Police and local authorities in managing the event to ensure that it is safe and as trouble free as we can make it. In order to achieve this we rely on those who operate licensed premises to identify and manage any additional risks that carnival presents. Where this premise is located is one of the main arterial routes in to carnival. This road remains open to public gans port and opposite Kensal Rise station which is

very popular access and egress for the crowds. It is also used as a link for those heading on foot towards Queens Park and Kilburn areas. This area of the London Borough of Brent is a controlled drinking Zone, drinking of alcohol in public area is prohibited. The sales of alcohol in open drinking vessels at this venue would simply be encouraging customers to break with the local authority legislation. This does nothing to promote the licensing objectives. In the past years the irresponsible supply of alcohol has had a negative impact on carnival visitors with the local community bearing the brunt of the antisocial fallout.

There was no Temporary Event Notice submitted last year. During carnival weekend 2013 the front decking was used by customers in addition to a large drum BBQ and speakers. Police Sergeant Jenkins visited the premises. Due to the high volume of music that was being generated resulting in members of the public gathering outside and blocking the highway Sergeant Jenkins requested the speaker be taken indoors and the volume turned down. If this Notice was to be honoured the licensing objectives would be breached by drawing large crowds from the sound system that would be blocking the highway and causing considerable noise nuisance to local residents. This could lead to a risk of disorder from overcrowding in such a small venue. The applicant has no experience in running music events or large crowds and there are no door supervisors employed at this premise.

Police request if this notice is honoured in full or part, the current conditions attached to the premises licence be adhered to on both Sunday 24th and Monday 25th August 2014.
