Police Objection to the Temporary Event Notice for O'Estadio Coffee Shop , 31A Station Road, NW10 on 15th November 2014.

I certify that I have considered the notice shown above and I wish to make **representations** that the use of the premises for the temporary event would undermine the crime prevention initiative, for the reasons indicated below.

An officer of the Metropolitan Police, in whose area the premises are situated, who is authorised for the purposes of exercising its statutory function as a 'Responsible Authority' under the Licensing Act 2003.

A Temporary Event Notice has been given under section 100 Licensing Act 2003 by Ms Manuela Rodrigues for 15th November 2014. The licensable activities applied for are provision of regulated entertainment and sale of alcohol.

Police are formally making representations to the notice under section 104 Licensing Act 2003. The Police objection is primarily concerned with the crime and disorder and prevention of public nuisance objectives.

The application is for a Private Party to run from 0800 to 0300 hrs.

Police request that all conditions currently attached to the premises licence be adhered to for this event. In addition the services of 2 SIA security officers would be required.

Should this be agreed I will be in a position to withdraw the representation.

I certify that I have considered the application shown above and **I wish to make representations** that the likely effect of the approval of the Temporary Event Notice is detrimental to the Licensing Objectives with regards to the prevention of public nuisance.

Recommendation

I recommend the following conditions to be attached to the TENs approval

Condition: No noise or vibration from the event shall be detectable at any neighbouring noise sensitive premises.

Condition: The licensee shall ensure that no music played in the licensed premises is audible outside. Music is not to be played outdoors. This condition applies to both amplified recorded music and live performances. A site supervisor will actively monitor the music/noise levels at the boundary of the premises and inform management and/or take appropriate action to remedy the issue immediately.

Condition: The external areas will be used for smoking only. The applicant shall actively monitor the smoking areas to control the number of patrons using the area and ensure any noise from them do not cause disturbance to local residents.

Observing these conditions will help meet the licencing objective related to public nuisance and potentially minimise complaints received by the Council. Please confirm by email, whether or not you are willing to accept the above proposed conditions. On the basis of your agreement to include this condition in your TENs approval, I will be able to withdraw my representation made against the proposed event.
