Objection to Application for a Premises Licence

To Whom It May Concern:

I am objecting to the application for a premises licence made by Gorillas Technologies Ltd for 113 Bryan Avenue London NW10 2AS.

This licence would include the supply of alcohol every day from 08:00 to 00:00 as part of a delivery service.

My main objection is that this is a quiet residential neighbourhood and that the extra traffic from the delivery trucks and motorbikes, vans etc would significantly add to the air and noise pollution for the many families who live here potentially destroying the peace and tranquillity of the area. The families and individuals that have moved here did so in the understanding that this area is, and always has been, residential.

The idea that delivery vans/trucks/motorbikes run continually through the day from 8am till midnight is unacceptable. The roads are not made for this increased traffic. It was only 1 month ago when a moped (delivery) driver crashed outside my house seriously injuring himself in the process – ambulance required. The road is narrow, on a hill with a noticeable bend with few places for cars to get past. The increase in traffic will make this quiet residential road less safe.
