RE: License Application Number 20885, 113 Bryan Ave, NW10 2AS.

I write as an owner occupier and have [REDACTED] in Bryan Ave since 1993. I strongly oppose granting a Premises license to Gorillas Technologies LTD for 113 Bryan Ave. This is a quiet residential street, The character of the street would change from peaceful to noisy and dangerous from increased traffic and activity.

Prevention of Public Nuisance

The operating hours 8AM to midnight seven days a week means there will be constant activity at the warehouse Big Trucks and Vans making deliveries. As they have a very small yard they will be stopping on the street and the rattling of crates and trolleys will be incessant. The licensing application states it is part of a delivery service, so the other goods delivered to the warehouse will add to this and create further problems of noise and nuisance. All this business will create a lot of waste from crates and packaging and these will have to be collected and disposed of.

Public Safety

An increase in Traffic will make the street more dangerous and increase pollution levels. Vehicles, bikes, e-bikes and motorcycles travelling at speed will be a danger to children and the elderly trying to cross the road. No doubt the riders will be working to a tight schedule when making deliveries.

Conclusion

I strongly recommend the licensing committee reject the application on the grounds of public nuisance and safety.
