The closing time for the premises to be 02:30 Sunday to Thursday, and 05:00 Saturday and Sunday.

An increase in the capacity of the premises to from 166 to 240 patrons.

If situations arise where the licensing objectives may be undermined but cannot be dealt with by the use of appropriate conditions the Licensing Authority will consider whether it is appropriate for a licence to be granted or continue to operate.
