Further to my below email I am disappointed that you have refused to engage with me through email, return telephone calls/voicemails or text message. I have used the following as a means of communicating with you

My colleague Avril Nightingale from Environmental Health has been recently able to contact you on these contacts. You have indicated to Avril that you no longer run the club. Our records show that you are the current Premises Licence Holder and we have no record of this licence being surrendered or transferred to another person. So, you have the legal responsibility in relation to the premises licence.

Your failure to engage with the Licensing Authority is of great cause for concern and leaves me with no alternative but to apply for a review of your premises licence as there is sufficient grounds to prove that Vybz Bar, 1 Craven Park Road, NW10 8SE has been undermining the licensing objectives relating to;

1. The Prevention of Crime and Disorder
2. The Prevention of Public Nuisance

Failure to provide the requested CCTV will also be treated as an offence under Section 136 of The Licensing Act 2003 for which you may be prosecuted in addition to the review of your premises licence.

I am making a formal request for a CCTV download from your premise at Vybz Bar, 1 Craven Park Road, NW10 8SE to assist my licensing investigation into complaints that your premise has been operating outside the permitted hours and to be in breach of a number of conditions as shown on Premises licence 318510. This has been communicated to you in a previous email.

I therefore request a CCTV download from **ALL cameras** at Vybz Bar to cover the following dates & times;

1. Saturday 28/05/2022 between 00.01am and 05.00am
2. Saturday 14/05/2022 between 00.01am and 05.00am

The premises has the following conditions attached in relation to CCTV.

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the operating schedule of the premises licence states;

1. CCTV shall be installed and maintained in a working condition.
2. All CCTV recordings shall be kept for 31 days and shall be made available to police and licensing officers if requested.

Please confirm when the CCTV is available for collection and I will make arrangement for this to be collected.

I must remind you that failure to comply with my request will leave you liable to be prosecuted under the Licensing Act 2003 and/or an application for a review of your premises licence.
