### **Annexe 2 - Conditions Consistent With the Operating Schedule**

- 2. A personal licence holder fluent in English shall be present on the premises and supervise the sale of alcohol throughout the permitted hours for the sale of alcohol.
- 3. A copy of the premises licence summary including the hours which licensable activities are permitted shall be visible from the outside of each entrance to the premises.
- 4. Substantial food and non-intoxicating beverages (including free drinking water) shall be available during the whole of licensed hours in all parts of the premises where intoxicants are provided.
