I want to see the pub doing well as it is an important part of the community. However, I do think that opening until 1:30 a.m. and selling alcohol until 1 a.m. is too late during the week. The noise and behavior, including fights, that this will bring will not be tolerable. I think closing at midnight and stopping serving at 11:30 more appropriate. I also think closing at 2:30 a.m. on the weekends will have too much of an impact on the community. This isn't a club! I think stopping serving at 12:30a.m. and closing at 1 a.m. more appropriate. I think doors and windows must be closed when music is being played. There are lots of residential addresses in the immediate vicinity.

Hi,

My concerns remain the same if it is the first floor only that is being extended. I don't agree with increasing the number of people present in the premises until the early hours of the morning.

I don't think the suggestions of the police that you have cited are sufficient to impact the violence that takes place as a result of people drinking. There was a stabbing at the Brondes Age pub across the road from this pub yesterday. Brent and Camden need to work together to reduce the violence on Kilburn High Road - extending hours, even if it is just for the first floor, will not help.
