
Newsfare – 33 Craven Park Road NW10 8SE – Further supporting evidence

Below is a map from the Metropolitan police web page (available to the public) highlighting the crime figures for the NW10 8SE post code. As you can see from this map the majority of the crime figures are in Craven Park Road where this application is.



The next image (from the same site) shows the breakdown of the crime types. Anti-social behaviour been the highest, followed by violent and sexual offences and finally drug related crime. This figures and maps speak for themselves. The connection between alcohol and crime is well documented and adding another off license to this area already suffering from these crime figures is the last thing the community of Willesden / Brent need.
