- a) General all four licensing objectives (b, c, d, e): The application is made to uphold the licensing objectives taking into consideration of the CIZ for this road. As a experienced retailer and a personal licence holder of over 15 years, will perform duties as a responsible retailer. Alcoholde will be kapt on one side of the store. Sprits will be behind the counter. Super strength lager will NOT be sold, so above 6.5%
- b) The prevention of crime and disorder: The premises shall install and maintain a digital CCTV system. The CCTV system shall have sufficient hard drive storage capacity to store a minimum of 31 days. 2 Cameras to be place outside, front of the store The CCTV system shall be capable of obtaining clear facial recognition images and a clear head and shoulders image of every person entering or leaving the premises at every entrance and exit point and at each point of sale. A CCTV log will be completed on a weekly basis to record that all elements of the CCTV System is maintained in good working order and recordings date and time stamped. Nominated staff shall be trained in the operation of the CCTV system to ensure rapid data retrieval & downloads of footage can be provided expeditiously to the Police & the Local Authority Officer upon reasonable request. CCTV shall be continually recording during licensable hours. In the event of a failure of the CCTV system for any reason, a record of the failure will be recorded in the premises log and immediate steps will be made to rectify the problem. An incident book must be kept on the premises and be made available for inspection by responsible authorities. The incident book must be used to record the following: (i) Any incident of violence or disorder on or immediately outside the premises ii) Any other crime or criminal activity on the premises (iii) Any call for police assistance to the premises. Prominent, clear and legible signage shall be displayed at all exits to the premises requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quickly and quietly. CCTV cameras will cover all areas that the public have access to, including the entrance, exit and pavement area immediately outside the premises. The licence holder will ensure the premises CCTV is provided to an officer from a responsible authority in a downloadable and viewable format within fourteen days of being requested. The licence holder will ensure that there is always a member of staff trained and available to download CCTV images/ footage immediately or an agreed timescale if requested by the police or the Licensing Authority. Litter bins to be made available externally. Posters stating - u201cStreet is drinking is not allowedu201d will be displayed. The licence holder will operate a Challenge 25 policy with the only acceptable proof of age identification consisting of a current passport, photo card driving licence, citizen card or identification carrying a PASS logo. All staff will be trained in alcohol sales, with records kept with log book. Staff will be ask to be vigilant in regards to proxy sales if a premises licence is granted.
- c) Public safety: 2 Cameras placed to front of store ,outside
- d) The prevention of public nuisance: Posters will be made to tell customers to leave quietly in the late evening
- **e)** The protection of children from harm: Posters of the following to placed on store windows and customer facing at the till area: NO ID NO SALE. CHALLENGE 25, PROXY SELLING, (illegal to buy for anyone under 18 yeas old).. Training book, for staff, incident book.
