a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d, e) (please read guidance note 10)

THE SHOP DOES OPERATE TO A HIGH STANDARD, AND WILL CONTINUE TO DO SO SHOULD THIS LICENCE BE GRANTED IN TERMS OF THE SALE OF ALCOHOL. STAFF WILL BE FULLY TRAINED IN THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES WITH REGARD TO THE SALE OF ALCOHOL, AND WILL BE RETAINED EVERY SIX MONTHS, THIS WILL BE KEPT ON THE RECORDED TRAINING FOR INSPECTION. THE SHOP WILL BE CLOSED 30 MINUTES AFTER LICENSING ACTIVIES HAVE CEASED, TO ALLOW CUSTOMERS ENOUGH TIME TO FINISH THEIR DRINKS AND LEAVE THE PREMISES QUIETLY TO DO NOT DISTURB ANY NEIGHBOURHOOD.

IN ORDER FOR OFF LICENSING ALCOHOL WILL BE MAINTENED IN A PLASTIC BAG AND CUSTOMERS WILL BE ADVISED NOT TO OPEN AT THE PUBLIC STREETS AND NOT TO SELL FOR PEOPLE WHO ARE SHOWING DRUNKENNESS AND UNDERAGE PERSONS.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

CCTV WILL BE USE AT THE SHOP, IT SHALL BE APPROPRIATE STANDARD AS AGREED WITH THE LICENSING AUTHORITY

IN CONSULTATION WITH THE POLICE.

CCTV EQUIPMENT WILL BE MAINTENED IN A GOOD WORKING ORDER AND CONTINUALLY RECORD WHEN LICENSABLE ACTIVITY TAKES PLACE AND FOR A PERIOD OF TWO HOURS AFTERWARDS.

PREMISES LICENCE HOLDER WILL ENSURE IMAGES FROM THE CCTV ARE RETAINED FOR A PERIOD OF 31 DAYS. THE IMAGE RETENTION PERIOD MAY BE REVIEWED AS APPROPRIATE BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY, THE CORRECT TIME AND DATE WILL BE GENERATED ONTO BOTH THE RECORDING AND THE REAL TIME IMAGE SCREEN.

AN INCIDENT RECORD WILL BE KEPT IN A BOOK, AS WILL REFUSALS FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOL. THESE BOOKS WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE POLICE OFFICER FROM THE COUNCIL ON REQUEST.

c) Public safety

STAFF WILL BE TRAINED TO BE ALERT TO ANY POTENTIAL DANGER TO CUSTOMERS AND REACT ACCORDINGLY. IF IN CASE THEY ARE UNABLE TO DEFUSE THE SITUATION WITHOUT RISK TO CUSTOMER OR STAFF, THEY ARE INSTRUCTED TO CALL THE POLICE. ALL RELEVANT FIRE PROCEDURES ARE IN PLACE FOR THE SHOP OF THIS SIZE. THERE WILL BE ON-SITE ACCIDENT BOOK IN OPERATION TO RECORD ANY ACCIDENT OR INJURY INCUREED ON THE PREMISES.

THIS DOCUMENT WILL BE RETAINED FOR INSPECTION BY THE BUSINESS FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS.
THERE WILL ALSO BE APPROPRIATE FIRE SAFETY PROCEDURES IN PLACE THAT INCLUDES FIRE EXTINGUISHERS
(FOAM, H20 AND CO2), FIRE BLANKET, INTERNALLY FIRE EXIT SIGNS, SMOKE DETECTORS AND EMERGENCY LIGHTING.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

I AM AWARE THE SHOP IS UNDER A CUMULATIVE IMPACT ZONE (CIZ), HOWEVER AS THE OPENING HOURS FINISHES AT 1930 THERE'S LESS RISK TO POSE NOISE POLLUTION, BUT GUESTS WILL STILL BE REMINDED BY WAY OF NOTICE AT THE ENTRANCE/ EXIT DOOR TO PLEASE LEAVE THE SHOP QUIETLY. CLEAR AND ELIGIBLE NOTICES WILL BE PROMINENTLY DISPLAYED TO ALSO REMIND CUSTOMERS TO LEAVE QUIETLY AND HAVE REGARD TO OUR NEIGHBOURS.

e) The protection of children from harm

ONLY PHOTOGRAPHIC ID IS ACCEPTED (PASSPORT, DRIVING LICENCE, PROOF OF AGE CARD WITH PASS HOLOGRAM, OR MILITARY ID). ANYONE THAT APPEARS TO BE UNDER AGE OF 25 IS CHALLENGED TO PROVIDE WITH AN ID. IF THE CUSTOMER IS UNABLE TO PROVIDE WITH AN IDENTIFICATION THEN NO SALE IS MADE. NO ID NO SALE. CHALLENGE 25 POS WILL BE ON DISPLAY IN THE STORE. IF THERE'S ANY STAFF MEMBER WHO IS UNDER 18 MUST CALL A SENIOR STAFF MEMBER TO DEAL WITH THE SALE AND FINISH TRANSACTION. IF IT IS KNOWN THAT A CUSTOMER INTENDS TO PURCHASE ALCOHOL TO PROVIDE TO A MINORS THEN SALE WILL BE REFUSED. ALL REFUSED SALES WILL BE RECORDED IN A REFUSALS BOOK, WHICH WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION BY POLICE OR LICENSING OFFICERS OF THE COUNCIL ON REQUEST.

ALL CHILDREN ON THE PREMISES WILL BE SUPERVISED/ ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES.

 - Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
 - Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display
 of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day,
 provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a
 contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial
 arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting
 event.
 - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
 - Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
 - Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
