Thanks for the information.

I don't really understand the point of the extended hours. On the face of it the business will operate exclusively as a takeaway after hours.

It would help if planning could confirm current Planning Permission.

My concern is the intensification of late night opening of another takeaway in Sudbury Town. There is currently no control of delivery drivers congregating and socialising and drinking in Sudbury Toen disturbing local residents. Corner of Rugby Avenue is one location and local residents in the nearby houses have already complained about late evening/early morning disturbance.

There are other outlets in Sudbury Town selling alcohol through the night. A few days ago people were sitting on the pavement outside the betting shop near Panesar eating pizza and drinking alcohol in the area as if the street was a picnic area.

Despite rules about street drinking Brent Council does not and is not capable of enforce the ban on street drinking. There are no Kate patrols.

In the mornings residents have to ease through piles of discarded bottles and cans and food packages. The street and the planters are full of the residual rubbish.

Allowing Licences for extended opening hours in Sudbury Town simply makes the situation worse.

I see no benefit of more outlets being able to open into the early hours of the morning making the current situation even worse

I see no proposals in the list attached if how the business can control and manage delivery drivers who drive over pavements cause disturbance and more litter in the area.

I oppose this application for extended operating hours which in no way benefit the local area and simply add pressure to the anti social behaviour which already occurs and which Brent Council or the business cannot prevent.
