The Police application relates to Prevention of Crime & Disorder, Prevention of Public Nuisance and Public Safety. The [REDACTED] supports the Police application for revocation of the License, in particular, on the grounds of Prevention of Public Nuisance as our residents have been affected by noise from the venue. The Police case is also strong in respect of the other licensing objectives. As [REDACTED] we have also made representations on the Appeal against the Enforcement Notice issued by Brent Council which is now with the Planning Inspectorate. We supported the action taken by Brent Council and noted that the appellant did not dispute that a breach of planning control had taken place. This is the second application for revocation of the licence and the Licence Holder has had ample opportunity to comply. Any further concessions are likely to mean more of a drain on police and official time in dealing with continuing non compliance. This would be difficult to defend to taxpayers. In addition it is depriving residents of a community facility that would be more appropriate in a park near residential areas and a Further Education facility and nursery.
