Resident	Large groups of men probably in HMO's on street corners drinking and loud , and Leaving bottles and cans. i feel sorry for them as HMO's leave them with nowhere to be but in parks
Resident	Drug dealing, Lime bike miss use, flytipping...
Resident	People with mental health disorders, crack and heroine addicts, professional beggars, and rough sleepers / encampments have become a common part of daily life in the community with negative impact on people's sense of safety.
Resident	Groups of mostly men street drinking in alperton along the canal. Also unacceptable amount of litter along the canal in alperton and park royal and Brent council does nothing to clean this up.
Resident	I find all the cars driving around in Paddington Old Cemetery far more detrimental to the peaceful experience there than a few dogs running around off-leash. Include a ban on private cars in cemeteries other than mourners.
Resident	Extensive Drug Dealing and Drug Usage in Public Spaces
Resident	All anti-social behaviour involving street-drinking, littering, spitting, making lots of noise especially while inebriated
Resident	Needs to be more education about dog fouling on pavements has got worse in nw2
Resident	Aggressive begging around underground stations and outside supermarkets - usually the same faces
Resident	1, People using public litter bins (on the street and in parks) to deposit residential or business waste. 2, People dropping their bagged dog waste in other people's residential bins as they walk past. 3, People having small events in parks (eg kids birthday parties) and leaving large amounts of bagged waste near the bins which then gets torn open by wildlife - if you have an event take all your waste home. 4, People rooting through other peoples bins and usually leaving a mess or taking food waste to dump elsewhere to feed wildlife
Resident	Men urinating in parks, antisocial behaviour in parks, littering
Resident	Public drug use on Kilburn high road and streatley road pocket park. Lack of policing.
Resident	Littering in parks. I love a picnic and we have great parks in Brent, but it's hard to enjoy when one sees other groups of people leaving their rubbish behind.
Resident	Mental health issues such as a naked man in the cemetery. Lone men loitering looking like they are doing drug deals in Paddington Old Cemetery
Resident	Littering in parks when good weater from picnic. My park is Gladstone park and Fryentway country park, the tidiness is gone, full of rubish. Cctv and fines could help a lot!
Resident	Shop lifters intimidating shop keepers; drunk and disorderly behaviour, messy streets, fly tipping, pot holes, uneven and dangerous sidewalk paving tiles, illegal drug consumption, drunk and disorderly behaviour etc parks like tiverton which are meant to be for kids and dog walkers being used for much of the above. You want our kids and dogs to play in those areas and yet they aren't safe, full of rubbish and broken glass, holes that they can easily trip and hurt themselves in whole running etc etc

	large groups gathering in king Edwards park urinating and playing loud music
	Drug using in Northwick park playing fields and anti-social behaviour not related to authorised users. Litter and glass strewn around the car park. Families and children at risk.
	Fly tipping, dumping rubbish on the street, or people chucking their rubbish out of their cars,
	Ranelagh Road (HA0 4TN) has a serious problem of drinking all night long on the road, spitting, peeing and littering.
	Convenience stores on and similar Willesden High Road using the pavement as an extension to their shops and taking up pavement space (particular examples are Al Shams Market, Apina Bazaar and Londis Supermarket but there are plenty of others.... This needs to be stopped. I'm not opposed to cafe's setting out tables where there is ample space - but the supermarkets should not be doing this as it contributes nothing to the appearance of the high street.... or the well being and safety of pedestrians....
	Parking violations during Carnival in Kensal Rise leading to blocked roads. People just accept getting tickets. Fines should be higher. Setting up of loud music just outside the Carnival area. This should be an offence and people moved on.
	My main concern is open drug use like crack cocaine being used openly on the street homeless people setting up tents in all the shop front on the High Street
	Too many dubious types lurk around Brent, probably drunk or high on drugs, especially in places like Monks Park, which is a no-go zone for children and families. Brent needs to introduce more policing consistently (and not wait for the murder of locals for this to happen), and a greater investment in and around Monks Park to allow locals to feel safe and free to use their local amenities.
	The lack of evidence is misleading Nitrous oxide is damaging to health - lowers B12 and is regulated by NHS maternity units to protect workers from exposure there is considerable evidence, cannabis in young developing brains under 24s can lead to psychosis risk and lack of drive to be self supporting or contribute to society. There is considerable evidence, through New Zealand studies in particular with a strong cohort of community use in the under 24s.
