This application follows the rejection of an application for a licence for an Adult Gaming Centre on these premises at the heart of Kilburn. While they want to call it a bingo hall, it will in effect be the AGC that has already been rejected : slot machines with a few iPads around which no-one will use for an impersonal, remote game of bingo. The clue is in the name of the operator - Golden Slots Ltd/Macau Casino Slots aren't interested in unluccrative bingo. If there were grounds to reject the original licence for an AGC, there must be grounds to object to this AGC in sheep's clothing.
