I want to object on the following grounds 1. Protecting children and other vulnerable persons from being harmed or exploited by gambling: It is right next to McDonalds largely used by young people with nowhere else to go and for whom it will be a magnet. It's also a short walk from several schools and a junction where teenagers hang out. 2. Preventing gambling from being a source of crime or disorder: It will pits a high risk of anti-social behaviour associated with late-night high-street gambling hubs and will add to the risk of shoplifting which is prevalent in this area. 3. Ensuring that gambling is conducted in a fair and open way: I believe that the Bingo branding is just a cover for more addictive slot machines. And should be stopped on grounds of prevention of disorder.
