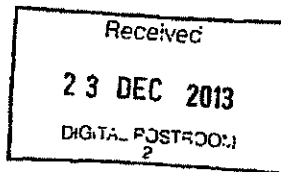

Dear Sir/madam

We the Harlesden Town Team would like to lodge an objection against the granting of a new premises license to Windrush 212, located at 212 High Street, Harlesden, London, NW10 4SY.

The reason for this is a number of residents have highlighted the following concerns:

- The premises used to be known as One Stop and were the cause of much anti-social behaviour. We are led to believe that it previously lost its late night license and this is simply a name change to gain it back.
- There is not adequate sound proofing to use the venue for late night entertainment. Residents and families living above the venue, and also at the top of Tubbs Rd, could not sleep due to the noise emanating from the back of the building when it had a late night licence previously. This seriously affected their quality of life and we fear this will occur again if the late night premises license is granted.
- We doubt there are adequate legal fire escapes for late night music events. They may claim these will only be small events but overcrowding appears to have been an issue in the past.
- There are also serious concerns on how people attending these proposed events until 4am will then get home. In the past bus drivers would refuse to pick these customers up due to their intoxicated state and this was the source of a lot of the anti-social behaviour as they had nowhere to go except to wait for the trains to start running.

We hope these concerns will be taken into consideration when considering Windrush 212's application.
