To whom it may concern,

I would like to raise an objection against the granting of a new late night license to Windrush 212, which is located at 212 High Street, Harlesden, London, NW10 4SY.

I have never raised an objection like this before but feel the need to do so. When I first rented a room where I now live on Tubbs Rd, just over a year ago, I found that one of the buildings, 212 High Street, which backs on to where I live, was used as a late night club. I found it difficult to sleep as the rear of 212 appears to be made out of breeze block and so offers very little soundproofing. I know my landlord and other residents also could not sleep because of the noise. I was relieved when about six months ago, I believe they lost the late night licence, and this extremely loud music, which occurred four nights a week until 4am, was stopped.

I see now that the owners are reapplying for a late night licence and I fear myself and the other residents quality of life will be severely affected. I have asked the other residents to also write objections, however, I fear because most of them have very limited English skills they will not be able to put their objections in writing.

It has also been noticeable for the last few months how much anti social behavior has declined since 212 has not been open until the early hours of the morning.

I hope before any decision is made you will investigate the noise pollution which emanates from the back of this building when loud music is played. Access to the rear of 212 is not possible from a public footpath but I know my landlady would be willing for anyone to come into the rear of her property so an assessment could be made.
