I am writing to object to the new premises license application for Wyndrush at 212 High Street Harlesden.

This location is not suitable for a late night club. There are residences directly behind the rear of the club, which have had to endure extremely high volume music and DJs from the nightclub which used to be at this location. In addition, there has been a high degree of loitering, delinquency, littering and antisocial behaviour associated with having nightclubs in this area. These problems afflict not just Harlesden high street, but also spill over onto Nightingale Rd. and Tubbs Rd.

Given the efforts Harleseden is making to make this neighborhood a better place to live and work, it makes no sense to allow this premises to open and undo the good progress that has been made already.

I implore you to think about not what is good for this particular business owner, but what is right for this community.

Finally, if you are inclined to grant this application, I hope that you will: 1) subject this nightclub to an acoustic test to gauge noise levels; 2) restrict their operating hours; 3) conduct random compliance audits; 4) require them to pay for extra police cover; and 5) make them pay for regular street clean ups.
