Dear Mr Bashir

I am writing this letter to bring to your attention my connection with your shop in recent weeks.

I visited the shop on 1200 hours on 5th August 2012 and spoke to your father, who I mistakenly thought, because of similarity of names, that he was the premises licence holder (PLH) and designated premises supervisor (DPS).

I then arranged with your father a meeting at Wembley Police Station.

This meeting occurred on 10th August 2012 both of your parents Mrs Tetrie Bashir and Mr Mohammed Bashir were present. They informed me you were actually the PLH and DPS of the shop and gave me a mobile number of 07940471007 to contact you. I have left several messages on this number and also phoned the shop and had further conversation with your father. I have not had any response from you.

During the meeting I spoke to your parents of how the operating of the shop is not upholding the licensing objectives, this included a sale of alcohol to a child at 1320hours on 30th June 2012, selling alcohol without authority, failure to display the premises licence and not having a certified copy of the premises licence at the shop for my inspection. Police have also witnessed and received complaints from local residents in relation to anti social behaviour from customers and misuse of drugs in and around the shop.

After discussion with your parents an action plan was handed to them. This plan is designed to assist you in the management of your shop so that it promotes the licensing objectives but you must make steps to contact me to discuss matters as soon as possible.
