I hereby request Brent Council to review the licence of The Woody Grill, 44 High Road, London NW10 2QA on the grounds listed below.

- 1. The flue at the rear of The Woody Grill emits smoke and fumes almost 24 hours a day 7 days a week which drift onto my terraces and into my home causing me great discomfort and difficulty breathing, particularly as I have emphysematous lungs (see medical report). It is sometimes so uncomfortable that I have to leave my apartment. The flue, which is situated within 5 metres of my home, also sometimes emits ash particles and the heat from it is intense, which may represent a fire hazard. It is so noisy that I can hear it in my home, even with all the windows and doors closed. I spoke to the manager twice about the annoyances the flue is causing in February 2013. I was verbally abused both times and was threatened with physical assault on the second occasion. The fumes and smoke from the flue are charring nearby buildings and polluting the environment. See photos 1 and 2 taken respectively at 12.30 p.m. on July 29th 2013 and at 16.30 p.m. on 30th July 2013.
- 2. The Woody Grill have refused to remove their refuse bin from Metropolitan Court property and their employees trespass to dispose of items in it and to dump sacks of rubbish by it, which entices others to do likewise. Their bin and the rubbish possibly restrict fire brigade access to the rear of Metropolitan Court and to Stephens Cottages (only access is through Metropolitan Court). I have seen members of the public urinate behind the bin, particularly late at night. See photos 3 and 4 taken at 9.45 a.m. on July 30, 2013 and photo 5 taken at 11.30 a.m. on August 4th 2013

- The Wood Grill stores containers of used fat (some open) in the rear of its premises. This is not only an eyesore, but also attracts vermin. I have seen a rat amongst the containers. See photo 6 taken at 3.15 pm on July 28th, 2013.
- 4. Some customers of The Woody Grill illegally park in or across the entrance to Metropolitan Court preventing access by the emergency services to the rear of Metropolitan Court and to Stephens Cottages. These illegally parked vehicles also prevent disabled drivers from entering Metropolitan Court. See photo 7 taken at 11.45 a.m. on July 29th 2013 of a car parked across the entrance to Metropolitan Court. I saw the occupants of the car go into the Woody Grill. See photo 8 taken at 12.30 a.m. on July 29th 2013 which shows a vehicle reversing out of Metropolitan Court entrance. I saw the occupants of the car come out of The Woody Grill.
- 5. Cars frequently park illegally on double yellow lines outside The Woody Grill. See photos 9 and 10 taken respectively at 14.15 p.m. on July 27th, 2013 and at 15.15 p.m. on August 4th 2013 which show busses being forced towards the centre of the road because of the illegally parked cars. I saw an employee of The Woody Grill get into the parked car in photo 9, which remained there for around 15 minutes. See photo 11 taken at 12.15 a.m. on August 4th 2013. The driver remained in the stationary vehicle for about 15 minutes, until he was served kerbside by a Woody Grill employee. See photo 12 taken at 12.45 a.m. on August 4th 2013. This vehicle remained on the double yellow lines for 14 minutes while the driver was in the Woody Grill.
- 6. I observed a drug exchange at around 3.25 a.m. on July 24th 2013 which took place in the entrance to Metropolitan Court behind The Woody Grill's bin. One of the persons involved in this crime came out of The Woody Grill. The crime has been reported to Willesden Green Police, who may be contacted for further details by the council. I understand from a neighbour that a further drugs crime in the same location has also been reported to the police.
- 7. The Woody Grill attracts customers very late at night, some of whom loiter outside making a lot of noise. I am sometimes unable to sleep because of the noise they make.
- It is unsuitable to have a very late night restaurant next door to a complex which contains 37 residential units.

- 3. Their rubbish bin is placed on Metropolitan Court vehicle access entrance, restricting access and attracting vermin

RE: Woody Grill, 44 High Road, Willesden, London, NW10 2QA

I wish to raise a complaint regarding the Woody Grill (noted above), in relation to unacceptable noise, smell and refuse.

The Woody Grill has an area outside at the back of the restaurant which is used by patrons. It is frequently noisy throughout the evening and into the early morning. The excessive noise causes a disturbance and prevents me from sleeping. I have been advised that they have a licence until 5:00 a.m.; if so, this should be curtailed to more sociable hours.

There are obnoxious fumes coming from the Woody Grill at various times of the day, emanating from the extractor fan. Depending on wind direction, these can be quite repugnant and induce nausea.

Finally, the Woody Grill site their refuse bin and deposit their litter on the private driveway belonging to Metropolitan Court. They have no legal right to do this. Furthermore, the refuse is unkempt, with large amounts lying loose instead of being deposited in the bin. In addition to looking unsightly, I believe it is a serious health hazard.

As a resident living at Metropolitan Count next door to the Woody Grill, I find the situation unacceptable and would ask that appropriate action is taken in respect of my complaint.
